The Decree of His Excellency Amir Al-Momenin on Lack of Jurisdiction of Military
Courts

Based on Sharia provisions, military courts have jurisdiction to hear and investigate complaints, claims, and appeals against the officials and employees of the three security organs of the Islamic Emirate (Ministry of National Defense, Ministry of Interior Affairs, and the General Directorate of Intelligence) and issue legal decisions if proved, but the decisions on *Hudud*, *Qisas*, and death penalty sentence shall be implemented practically after the approval of the three-tiered courts and the leadership of the Islamic Emirate.

The three security organs of the Islamic Emirate are strictly required to support the implementation of the decisions made by the military courts.
